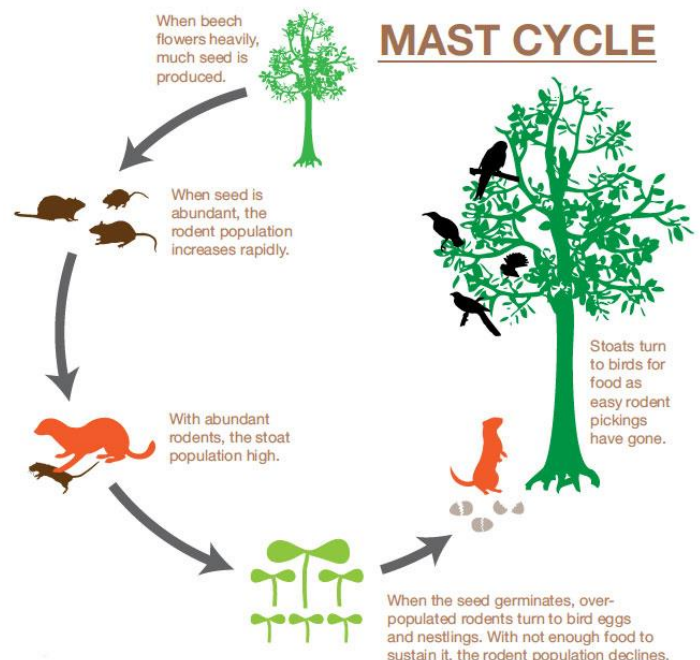
This diagram explains about a mast year.
